#### **START LOCATIONS**

1. Windsor McDonalds, Windsor Rd, McGraths Hill (Enter via Groves Ave). Meet by 7:45AM for an 8:00AM briefing and departure by 8:15AM.
2. Alternative start for those coming from the Blue Mountains, Central West: Meet at McDonalds Restaurant, Cnr Gt Western Hwy and Main St, Lithgow by 9:45AM for a 10:30AM departure. This will be the first scheduled stop on our route.

We'll be crossing the Blue Mountains via the Bells Line of Road, stopping at Lithgow. We'll then be travelling along the Castlereagh Highway as far as Ilford, from there heading to Sofala.
