Along the route there are a number of roadside stalls selling farm produce. Bring along your small change to enjoy something fresh to take home from the farms.



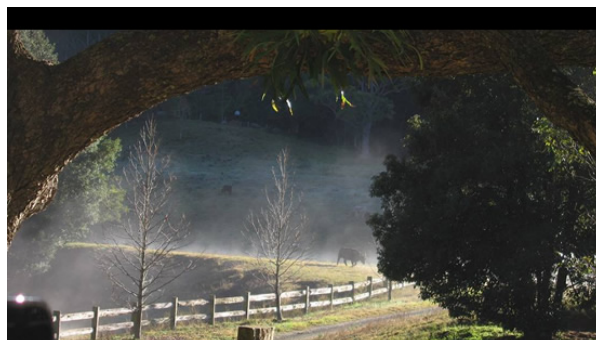
